International Participation for Expo Doha Qatar 2023





The official logo for the Expo 2027 Yokohama was unveiled on 8 February at Machi Place Conference Center (Yokohama Keizai Shimbun).

Mr Yuko Kita created the winning design. The official logo competition ran during October and November last year, and the Yokohama Expo 2027 organisers selected the winning logo from among 1,204 entries.



Expo 2023 Suncheon Bay International Garden park is nearing completion and will be ready for the opening date of 1 April. The International Horticultural Expo will transform the entire city centre into a garden under the theme of "living in a garden."

Alongside the preparations for the Expo, Suncheon City has signed an agreement to help protect the native Hooded Crane.
